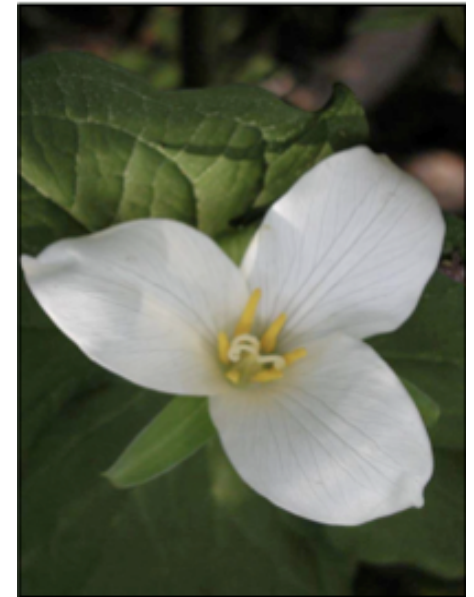

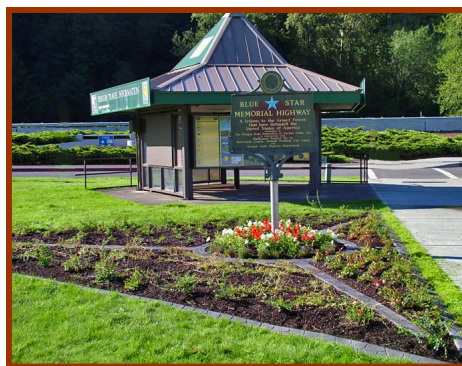
Club Projects & Community Support
